1. Longevity
 - a. This refers to the amount of time an individual has been involved in the activities.
2. Community Involvement
 - a. This refers the amount of volunteer work an individual does with the goal of improving the community.
3. Professional Involvement
 - a. This refers to the effort an individual devotes to their industry, whether in education, professional associations etc.
4. Innovation & Entrepreneurship
 - a. Refers to innovative new products, processes etc. As well, the ability to expand the operations through entrepreneurship.
5. Stewardship
 - a. Refers to an individuals commitment to stewardship (defined as: the wise management and use of resources).
